St. Vladimir Church Donating Directives

✓ What are the financial requirements of a voting member?

The parish of St. Vladimir requires financial resources in order to exist. We must pay for things like building rent and upkeep, liturgical supplies, and our priest's salary. In addition, we give 10% of our monthly income to the Archdiocese of Canada (OCA). This tithe stays in Canada. This is all documented in the monthly financial statements which are available to everyone. We ask that voting members familiarize themselves with and contribute to these financial needs. We do not have parish dues, nor do we wish to become dependant on fundraising. The norm of Christian giving is the tithe, i.e. 10% of one's income. If one is not already tithing one should be working toward this norm. Below is a guide to proportional giving:
